Airborne on Ashton Park FREE EVENT

On Saturday the 27th April, Friends of Ashton Park will be celebrating all things 'airborne' on Ashton Park, particularly the arrival of the Wren monoplane, built by English Electric (now BAE Systems) in 1923 at their works in Lytham St Annes. They are using this anniversary to celebrate all the flying things in the park – from birds, insects and seeds to footballs, golf balls and cricket balls, by constructing, decorating and flying kites on the park during the day.

There are 60 free kites to give away and everyone is welcome to bring their own. Artfull, an arts group local to the park, will be running the activity from 10.30am, and hope fully everyone will fly their kites together between 2-3pm for a video. Taking Children Out Of School During Term Time

A very important message for all parents. We will not authorise parents taking children out of school during term time for family holidays.

Any unauthorised leave during term time may risk families receiving a penalty notice or legal action being taken.

Should a penalty notice be issued, each parent will be fined a minimum of £60 or £120 depending on how soon payment is made.

If the fine is not paid, you may be required to attend Court and this could result in a fine for each parent of up to £1000 per child and a Criminal Record.
