Termly Non-Negotiables

Vocabulary, Grammar and Punctuation

I can say my sentence and hold it in my head while I write it.

I can write sentences that other people can read.

I can use **spaces** between my words.

I can use **full-stops** in my writing.

I can use a **capital letter**s in my writing. I can use **capital letters** for names of people, places, days of the week and the personal pronoun I.

I can use **exclamation marks** in my writing.

I can use question marks when I write questions.

I can join two sentences with 'and'.

I can join two sentences with 'but'.

I can join two ideas together with 'or'.

Composition: Planning

I can tell a story with an **opening, middle** and **end**.

I can put my information in order in a non-fiction text.

Composition: Drafting & Writing

I can say my sentences out loud before I write them down, using the joining words **'and'**, **'but'** and **'or'**. I can re-read my sentences to check that they make sense.

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I can write my own stories with my own sentences, including some with joining words. I can write non-fictions texts with my own sentences, including some with joining words.

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Composition: Evaluating and Editing

I can talk about my writing, saying what is good about it e.g. 'My handwriting is good because ...'; 'The best word I have used is...'; 'I am proud of my writing because...'

Composition: Performing

I can read my writing out loud to the whole class.

Handwriting

I can show clear ascenders and descenders in my writing. I can form ALL lower and upper case letters correctly.

Spelling

I can spell most of the Year 1 common exception words and high frequency words correctly.
