I can use evidence to explain my inferences.
I can make a sensible prediction using clues from the text.
I can form a simple hypothesis about a non-fiction text using clues.
I can close read, re-read and read ahead.
I can discuss themes in poetry.
I can compare settings.
I know the difference between fact and opinion.
I can use main points from paragraphs in a summary.
I can use P+E+E in my longer answers.
