

Art and Design Curriculum – Visual Long-Term Plan

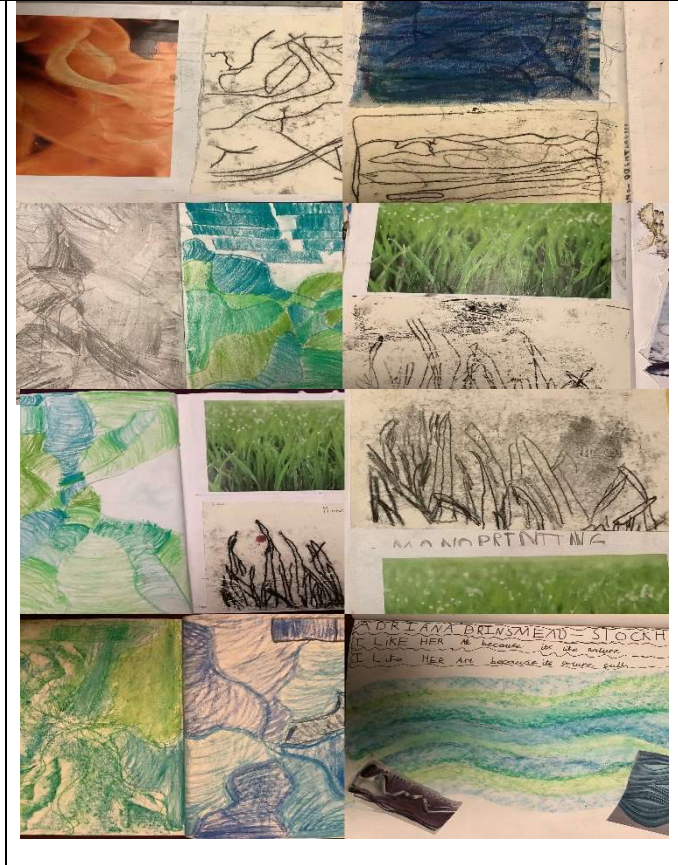
