

ClassCharts

As many of you know, Classcharts is our system for logging positive and negative behaviours of students. Most of you already use the ParentApp and are able to look at the points that are logged each day.

When we started with this new system, our goal as staff, was to demonstrate our FAITH values by 'lavishing love' on our students. We do this by logging all of the positive behaviours that we see from our students.

It is always extremely impressive to see how many points are logged by staff which in turn, reflects how much positive behaviour they see. The following pie chart shows the balance of points from the first four weeks of term.



134 372 positive points have been logged so far. That is extremely impressive! A huge well done to all of our students and a big thank you to staff too for rewarding these positives.
