Students of Derby Cathedral School are given every opportunity and challenged to be the best that they can be, demonstrating FAITH in all they do.

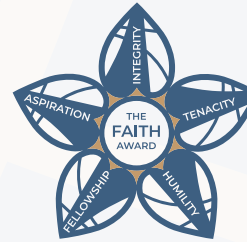
Each week our students will use part of their tutor time to discuss our school values and how we can demonstrate the following values in all aspects of our lives:

FAITH in Action

Fellowship

Fellowship is a value that is so important in schools. We all know that it is not always easy to get along with one another but we believe that the success of a community, both inside and outside of our school walls, lies in our ability to treat others with dignity and kindness.

It is important to us that our students carry on this trait in all aspects of their lives so that they are able to grow as individuals who can find their place alongside everyone else in the world.

Aspiration

To be successful we need to be ready. On a small scale this means having the correct equipment at the start of every day so that learning is not interrupted. Our students must be organised and think in advance about the learning that they will be carrying out that day – do I know what lessons I have? Do I have my homework, kit or ingredients?

On a larger scale – it is about preparing our students for the next steps in their educational journey.

We support our students in looking to the future – helping them to explore the routes to college, apprenticeships and higher education.

We believe that all students need to be the best that they can be in all situation, even when they are finding something challenging. Self-belief and motivation are critical if we are to achieve our potential in life.

Integrity

Derby Cathedral School is a place of equity where every member of our community is valued. We believe that our school is a place of opportunity for all and it is so important that we treat everyone with fairness.

Students at Derby Cathedral School are taught the value of honesty. We all make mistakes, that is how we learn; the most important lessons are learnt when we accept this important fact and remain true to ourselves.

We encourage our students to be reflective and positive, honest and fair—doing the right thing even when no one is looking' These attributes make our school a happy place to be.

Tenacity
