Captain Hook/Mr Darling 16+
Both characters are played by the same actor.

Mrs Darling 16+
Wendy's mother whose wonderful bedtime stories attract Peter to visit.

Wendy Darling Able to play a 14-year-old girl.
A practical young lady and one of the few people capable of standing up to Peter Pan.

Tiger Lily | Flower Princess
Able to play a 14/15-year-old girl.

John Darling Able to play a 10-12-year-old boy.
The elder of Wendy's younger brothers

Michael Darling Able to play a 6-9-year-old boy.
Wendy's youngest brother.

Pirates 16+
Smee Able to play a dame for one scene, an oddly genial optimist.
Noodler Naïve and funny, slapstick performer.
Starkey / Foggerty

Lost Boys | Able to play 8-15-year-old boys.
Tootles / Nibs / Slightly / Curly

Nana the dog Any age.
Will be required to crawl around the stage.

The Flower People x 4 (Dancers) - Any age.
