Devizes Dispatch Canteen Meal Deals & Free School Meals

We wanted to inform all parents of a recent change to our canteen's meal deals that are available to students each day, particularly those in receipt of a free school meal. To encourage variety, a healthy diet & to make the most of the value of a free school meal, the canteen offers a variety of deals that students can take advantage of. These include:

- Main meal deal of the day the main meal on offer, dessert & water bottle/juice box (this always includes options for those who are vegetarian or have dietary requirements, as well as Jacket Potatoes)
- The Grab & Go meal deal of the day- a selected grab & go item, dessert of the day & water bottle/juice box
- A sandwich item & water bottle/juice box
- A sandwich item and fruit pot/dessert pot

The meal deals are on offer to those in receipt of free school meals, or for a cost of £2.70 each day. Please note that the Grab & Go meal deal now specifies a different grab & go item each day, ranging from pizza, paninis and wraps. If a child wishes to have items that differ to the meal deals on offer, please note that these are not included in the deal, which may mean that their chosen meal exceeds their daily allowance for a free school meal, and have to then come at additional cost to the student via the student's ParentPay account. They therefore can either make the most of the deal on offer or select individual items within their own allowance and/or topped up by their personal budget.

As stated above, these deals encourage students to eat a wider variety of food and to choose ideally the main meal option, therefore maximising the value of the free school meal for each child. This in line with all schools across the White Horse Federation, as a part of their contract with Caterlink. If you have any questions about this, do please get in touch.
