

Hello Devonshire,

It's been another busy week at Devonshire!

On Wednesday, a small group of pupils enjoyed a fantastic visit to the Creative Space Centre in Preston, the largest multi-sensory centre in the UK. The children were fascinated by the state-of-the-art lighting, visuals and sound equipment that help create fully tailored sensory experiences for visitors. As a centre that has been providing sensory support for those with additional needs for over 30 years, it offered our pupils an inspiring and inclusive environment to explore. Thank you to all staff who supported the trip, and a special thank you to Miss Stowell, whose excellent leadership and organisation made the day such a success.

Our school is proud to offer a wide range of extra-curricular clubs each term, giving children the chance to explore new interests, build confidence and develop skills beyond the classroom. This term, pupils are getting involved in cookery, computing, choir, netball, science and Y6 booster clubs; each designed to spark curiosity, encourage teamwork and provide enjoyable learning experiences in a relaxed setting. We believe that enriching opportunities like these help our children grow socially, creatively and academically and we encourage all families to take advantage of what's on offer. New clubs will begin after February half term so keep your eye on Parentapp as this is the only way to sign up.

I'd like to remind all parents and carers that our Primary Mental Health Worker visits school every Tuesday from 2:00pm - 4:00pm for drop-in sessions. This is a supportive, confidential opportunity for families to seek advice on a range of wellbeing topics, including managing worries, building resilience, supporting behaviour and understanding children's emotional needs. You don't need an appointment; simply drop in if you'd like to chat or explore strategies to help your child thrive both at school and at home; though you may have a small wait during busy times. We encourage anyone who feels they may benefit to come along.





Space Centre, Preston






