Jungle Class

Children begin Preschool the September before they are due to start school. Jungle class have access to our extensive learning environment as well as the school trim trail, sensory room, dance classes, sports coach and regular balance bike practise.

Jungle class take part in the Blackpool tooth brushing scheme and Pre-school council where they are given the responsibility to make decisions about their learning and environment. We also have our own preschool library where children can borrow books to take home.

Jungle Cubs

Children who begin preschool in January or the term after their 3rd birthday are referred to as our Jungle Cubs. Jungle cubs have access to the same resources and learning opportunities as the Jungle class. They will continue their learning journey through to Jungle class in the September.

Preschool Hours and session times

Our pre-school is term time only (not open during the school holidays).

We open at 8.45 am and close at 3.00 pm Monday to Friday.

Important information

Snack and Sundries

Sundries are charged at £1 per week and are paid through the parent pay app in advance of every month. Sundries covers the cost of items such as snack, fruit, juice, sun cream and wipes. Sundries also goes towards events such as parties and special occassions eg. valentines disco, trips to lidl/costa and our termly special events with parents.

During Snack time, children will help themselves from a selection of fruit with a choice of milk or water to drink. We offer a variety of snacks such as croissants, brioche, fruit loaf, waffles, pancakes and pastries. Fresh fruit is also available every day.

Your 15 or 30 hours funded childcare from the government does not cover the cost of these items. You will be given information on how to access parent pay during your child's first week in preschool.









Arrival and Collection

On arrival, please bring your child to the double doors as they are welcomed in by a member of staff. At this time, any relevant information can be passed on to staff.

At the end of the session, please wait by the double doors where we will dismiss each child one at a time to ensure safety. A member of staff may wish to speak to you at this time. It is very distressing for a young child to be left after the other children have gone home so please be on time.

Preschool Bag

Please bring a small bag each day to pre-school. In your bag you should have;

A spare set of clothing, socks and underwear.

Pull ups (if required).

Your pre-school bag should be taken home and brought back daily.

Water

Please do not bring a water bottle as your child will have access to cool, fresh drinking water from our water machine. Our staff can track how much the children are drinking daily when using our preschool cups to ensure that they have enough.

Devanshire School Uniform

Learning is a messy job! Each mucky mark is linked to a skill that children need to practice in order to perfect it. At pre-school we always use aprons and waterproof jackets. However, it is still possible for children to get messy. Because of this, we recommend that children wear the Devonshire uniform.

Wearing the uniform will help your child by making them feel part of the team, and means that you don't have to worry about spoiling their 'best' clothes.

School uniform can be purchased from Ragamuffins or Tesco.

Please label all uniform, bags and coats with your child's name.


(During the summer, girls may wear a light blue gingham dress)


Class Dojo is a school communication platform that teachers, students, and families use every day to build close-knit communities by sharing what's being learned in the classroom home through photos, videos, and messages.

Settling in

At Devonshire Pre-school we want your child to feel safe and happy in your absence. We would love your children to be able to recognise our staff as a source of help and friendship and to share their pre-school experience with you at home.

We understand that there may be some children who take longer than others to settle in and, where necessary, we will encourage you to leave your child for brief periods, gradually building up to longer absences.

We sometimes find that children will often settle better and quicker if the parental guardian is not there. However, this is not true for all children and nobody knows your child better than you!



If you leave your child and they have shown no signs of settling, we will ring you. We would never allow a child to be upset for a long period of time. We can then discuss with you what the options are. You will always be kept in the loop – even if your child has settled, we'll still let you know. We will try various methods to calm your child. From lots of hugs to distraction techniques, we'll always put your child first and try to accommodate them. If you are at all concerned, please give us a ring at any point.
