Year 3 History Trip

On Tuesday, Year 3 went on a very exciting trip to Tatton Park. We are now experts on the stone age, bronze age and iron age! We engaged in four different activities to learn about: how to make fire, different stone age tools, farming and shelter building. The Year 3 children displayed excellent behaviour and soaked up many new facts.

- ◆ From 8:45am, children will be encouraged to grab a bagel/toast or piece of fruit and go to class for early morning task.
- ◆ Any child wishing to attend **Breakfast Club** **MUST** enter through the school hall.
- ◆ There will be a variety of activities on offer for the children every morning.

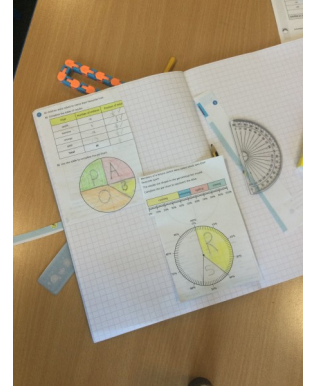
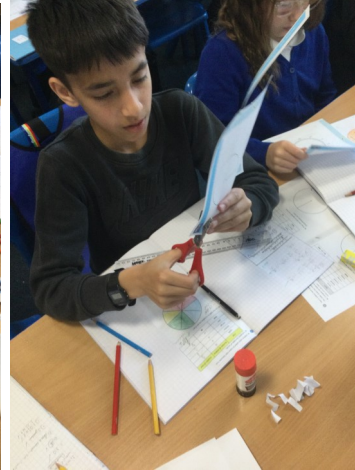

This Week in Year 6

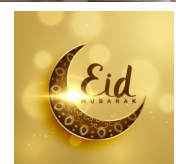
This morning in 6B the children worked really hard on drawing pie charts! I was very impressed with how the class referred back to previous learning on percentages and angles to support them with this lesson!

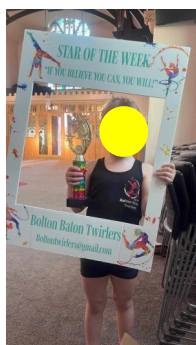

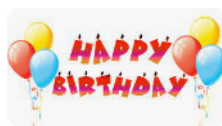

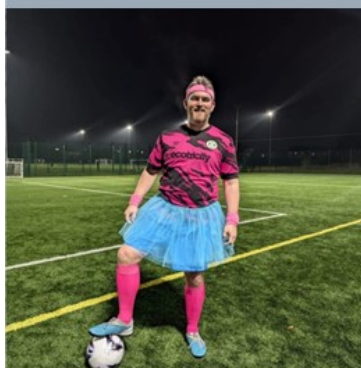
