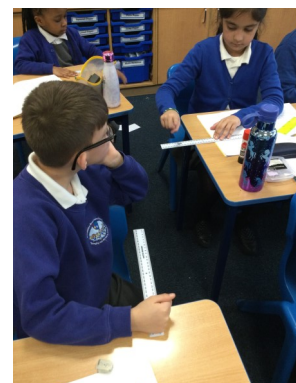
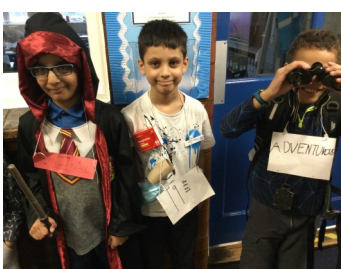


We started our week with Sound in Science where we tested different materials and rated their pitch and loudness. We twanged rulers to see how they made different noises.
