Thank you to Mrs Cavanaugh and our Parent Volunteer, Mrs Ali, for supervising and supporting the children on the day.

The children told us all about their experience...

'We had to build a rocket out of paper cups, straws and elastic bands, using our own design, the task was to build a rocket that would land softly.'

The children discovered that William's favourite word is 'suspension'! He was so determined to get the suspension just right to ensure a soft landing at the very last minute.

'We came 3rd out of 45 primary schools around 216 child in total. We are very proud of ourselves!'

All of the children told us that they are really interested in science and rockets and when asked which one would go to the moon first, it was a tie between Chloe and William!

Adam said he liked solving the maths problems because they were tricky and similar to the maths task on Countdown!

Mrs Cavanaugh told us that the children also had to solve a sorting diagram which was based on a text about rockets and they all showed true resilience when they built a 170cm high tower using just straws and Blu Tac!

It sounds like a very interesting and challenging day!
