Year 1 had a fabulous stay and learn event. There was a great turnout from parents and carers who read with their children, played bingo, board games and phonics play.

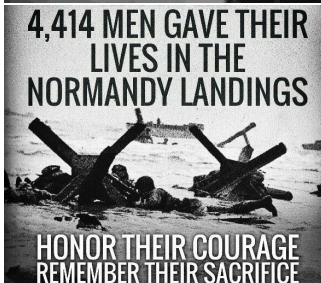
The children have also enjoyed active phonics activities throughout the week in preparation for their phonics screening check next week.

At the end of the service, The Mayor laid a wreath outside the church and The Mayor's Cadet, Cadet Corporal Murphy Hall, lit a beacon on the top of the church. Beacons were lit across the country at the same time.

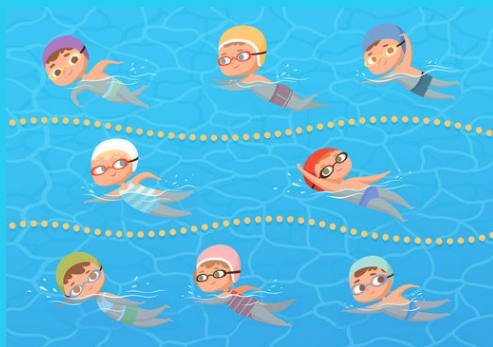

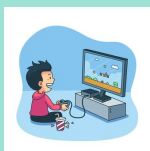

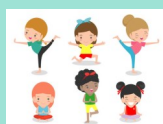
