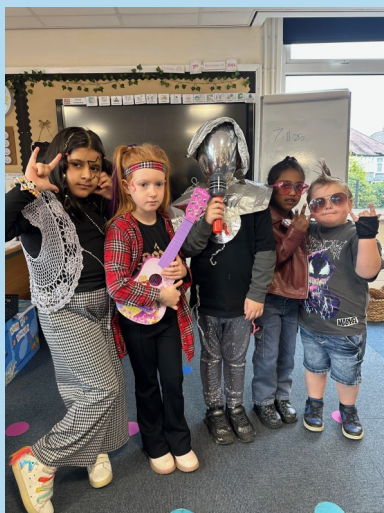

Number Confidence Week

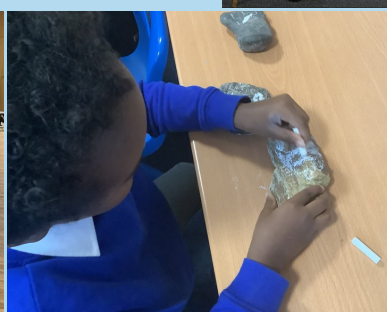
TT Rockstars and Numbots Day is always one of our children's favourite days of the year!
