

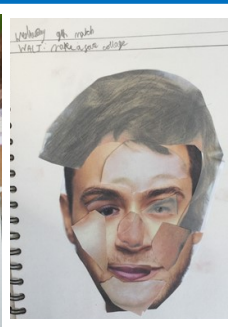
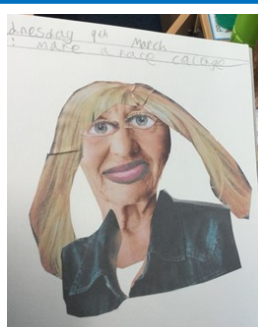

## Comic Relief

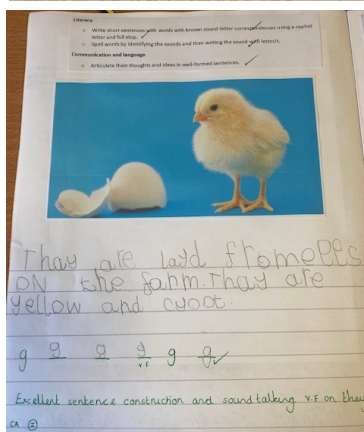
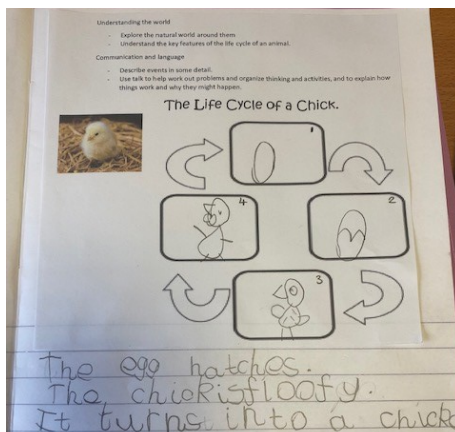
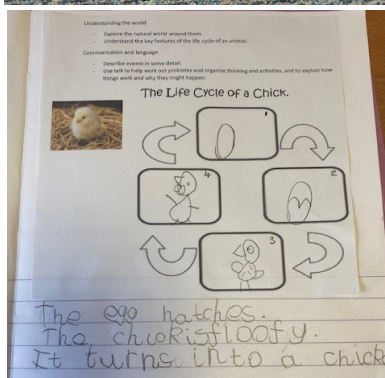
Next Friday is Red Nose Day. Children are invited to come to school in sports gear in exchange for a £1 donation. There are still red noses for sale £1.50 in the school office.

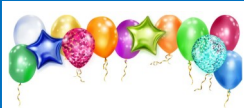
