National Anti-Bullying Week 2022

This week we have been recognising Anti Bullying week. The week started off with a whole school anti bullying assembly lead by Mrs Hodge. She told us all about the importance of being an 'upstander' and not a 'bystander' if we see any bullying occurring. On this day, children came in wearing 'odd clothes' to show that we are all different, and that these differences should be celebrated. All classes have also completed anti bullying themed work in their PSHE lessons. On Wednesday, our fantastic Peer Mentors were trained by Kidscape. They were taught about what bullying may look like, different types of bullying and how to recognise body language in children that may indicate their feelings. They then discussed different bullying scenarios and thought about how they could help the situation as peer mentors. The trainer was very impressed with how well the children participated.

All children received an anti-bullying wristband.



Wednesday 16 November
Our peer mentors will be at the parent/carer 'Coffee and Conversation' Morning to talk to you about all they have learnt in their training.

This week our peer mentors have had training by Kidscape on being an anti-bullying 'champion.' They learnt about what bullying might look like, different types of bullying and how to help resolve situations that may occur on the playground. Each class has been allocated a peer mentor they can go and talk to during lunch time. The trainer was so impressed with the children and how well they participated in the session.

Coffee and Conversation

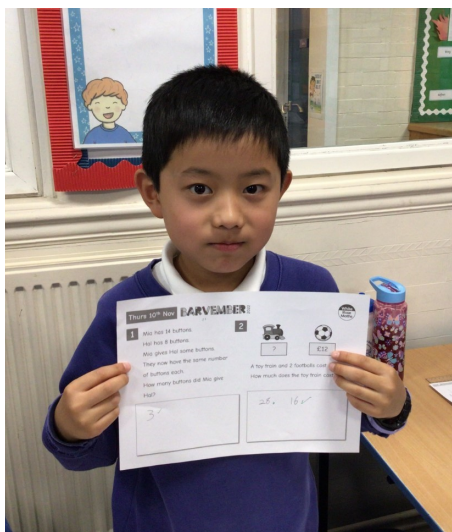
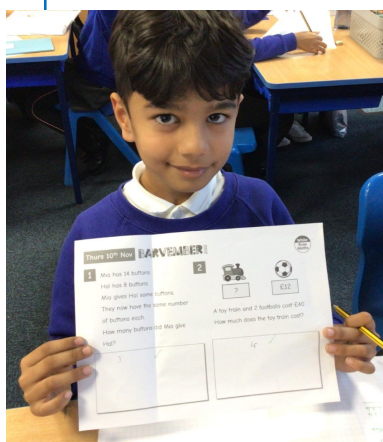

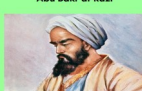

It was a fantastic week for attendance, with 7 classes achieving over 98%. Well done to Y4HB who won Class of the Week for the second week running with 99.4%.



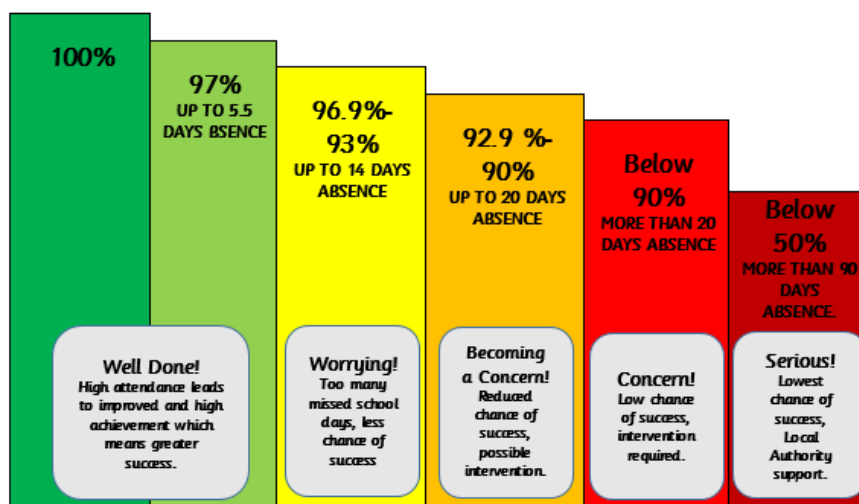
Celebrating Excellent Punctuation

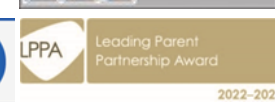
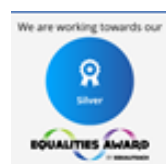
