All classes have also completed anti bullying themed work in their PSHE lessons. On Wednesday, our fantastic Peer Mentors were trained by Kidscape. They were taught about what bullying may look like, different types of bullying and how to recognise body language in children that may indicate their feelings. They then






Class of the term to date: Y4W &Y6B 97.4% This is fantastic, keep going!


Celebrating Excellent Punctuation
