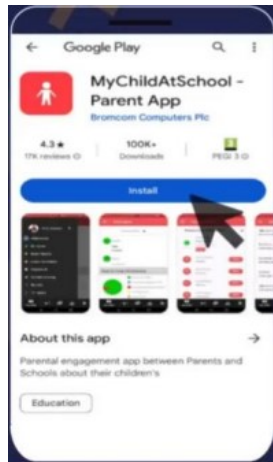
- * Pay dinner money

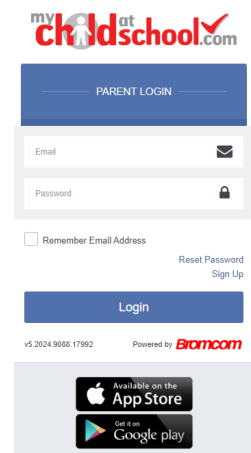
