EYFS Toy Workshop



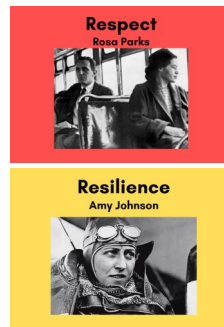

"We can get better at things like writing when we practice it every day in class." Chloe E Y5M



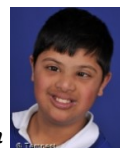
