Our new Chequers Club is proving really popular. We have some amazing tacticians. Well done on some very intense games and great sportsmanship!

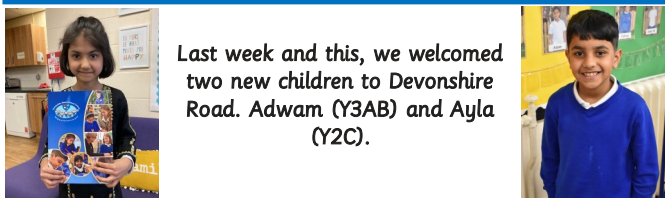

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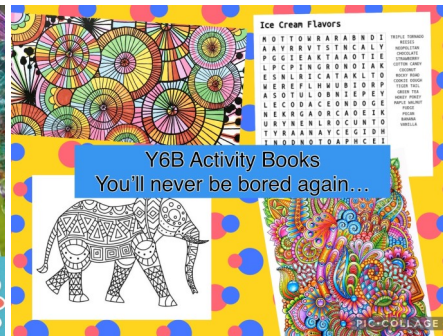
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## Enterprise Week
