








Computing

This is as a direct response to the comments from the school community to help each of our families. Every child that returns their homework will be rewarded with House Points. COVID's Still Here

We are sharing information about Greater Manchester Combined Council's new COVID awareness campaign, 'COVID's Still Here'. More useful information can be found at: Covid Still Here - Greater Manchester Combined Authority (greatermanchester-ca.gov.uk)

The campaign has been updated in line with the move to 'Plan B' and stresses the importance of keeping everyone safe through useful tips including:

- Take a LFD test at home before attending busy events

Key Stage 2 Choir


