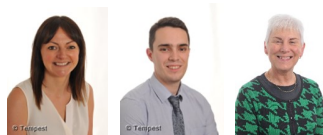

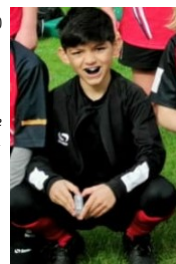

392 children came into school on time each day they attended.

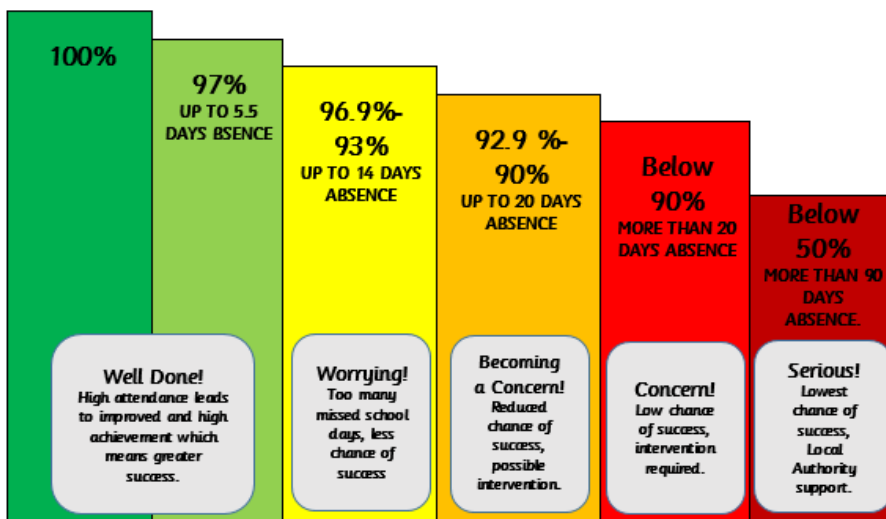

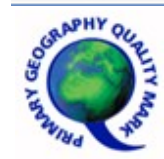
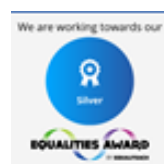
