378 children came into school on time each day they attended.

We have been extremely proud of our attendance at Devonshire Road this term, our whole school attendance for the year to date is 95.4%, which is above the National Average (94.5%).

Aiming for Excellent Attendance

Next Thursday, during our Celebration Assembly, we will be holding our termly attendance draw. Every child with 100% for the term will be entered into a draw for a £50 Amazon voucher and every child with attendance 97% and above will be entered into a draw for a £25 Amazon voucher. There are currently 85 children on 100% and 184 with at least 97%.

From January, we will also be celebrating and rewarding excellent punctuality, more information will be shared at the start of the spring term. To support parents/carers in the mornings we have a breakfast club which runs from 7:45am and for just £1.50 children can enjoy a healthy breakfast, fun activities and help with reading and homework.
