First Aid Sessions

This week, Years 1 - 6 have received some basic First Aid training from Pheniks Division. They have learnt the difference between a heart attack and sudden cardiac arrest and what steps they need to take if they find someone who has collapsed. They practised chest compressions using their teddies and who they need to call when they need help. Questions you can ask

your child: how long do you need to listen to see if someone is breathing? Which number do you need to ring in an emergency? Which song can you sing to help you keep in time with chest compressions?
