

#### Road and Parking Safety

It is ALL of our responsibilities to ensure that children, parents/carers and the wider community are safe on the local roads. Please be considerate, park safely and drive at no more than 10mph around the school perimeter.



#### Slow down and concentrate:

- \* Always drive slowly—20mph or below in communities, 10mph around the school
- Switch your phone off and put it in the glove box

#### Don't drive children all the way to school:

- \* Try to walk to school where possible
- If it's too far to walk, try and park safely some distance from school and walk the rest of the way
- Always drive considerately, be aware of pedestrians and other vehicles

#### Fit and use child restraints:

- \* ALWAYS use a baby or child seat suitable for your child's size and weight
- \* Rear facing seats are safer for babies
- Children under 150cm tall MUST use a child seat
- ALWAYS check that All children are restrained before setting off

#### Never:

- Never hold a child in your arms in a vehicle
- Never use one adult seat belt to restrain more than one person
- Never carry anyone else's child in your car if you do not have an appropriate child restraint
- Never allow someone to travel unrestrained
- \* Never leave children alone in vehicles
- \* Never park on the zig zags
- Never block a driveway
- Never drive down Baines Street or block the
- entrance to Baines Street at school drop off or pick up
- Never do a U turn on Devonshire Road


