This week the children made, fruit kebabs, banana bread, smoothies and granola pots!



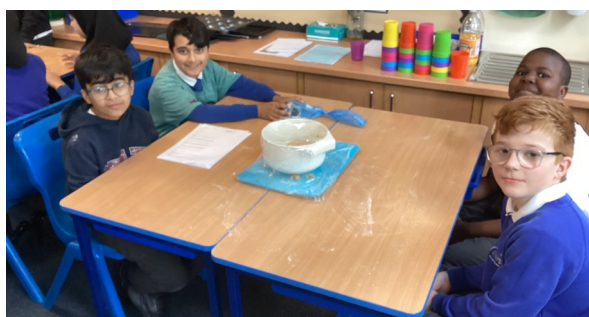

This week in year 5, the children continued their D & T bread topic and made their own bread, their were some very imaginative additions!





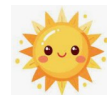

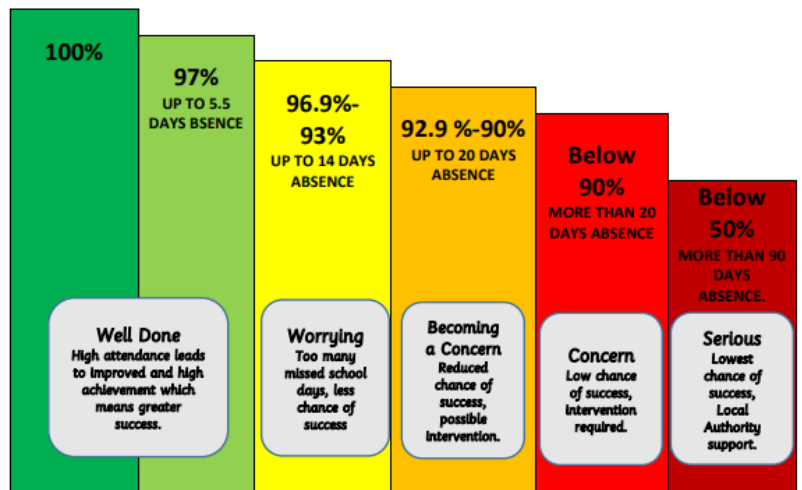
