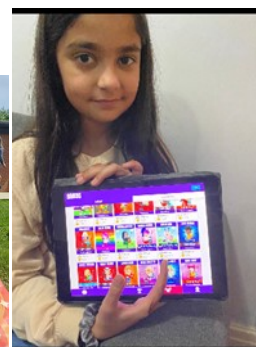
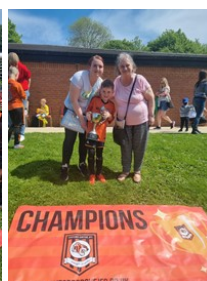

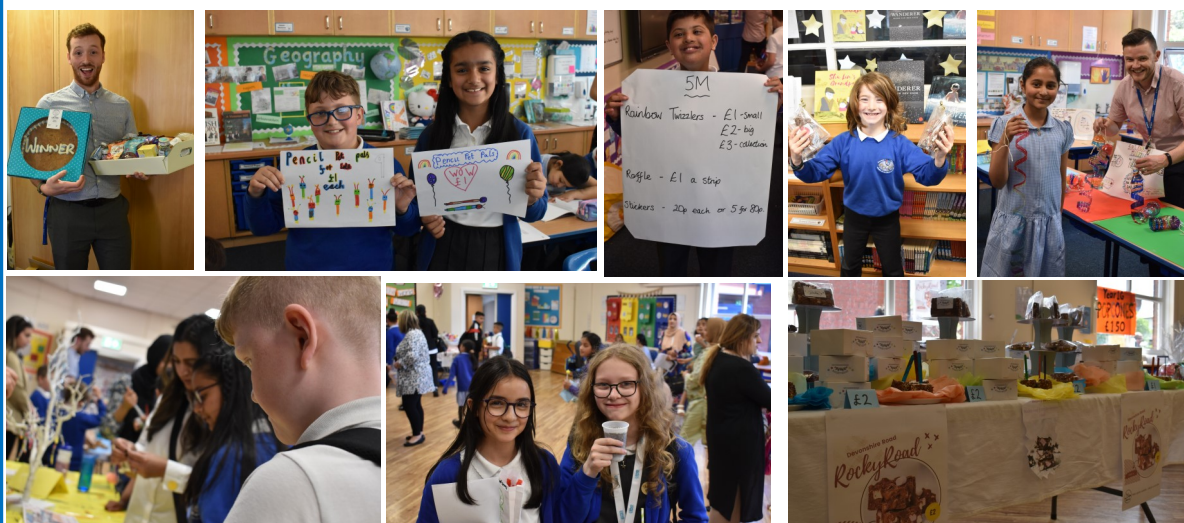

Our journey through school together builds strong foundations and a love of learning which encourages aspirations and ambitions for the future.

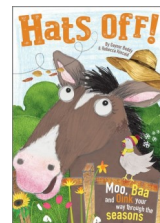
EYFS Performance
