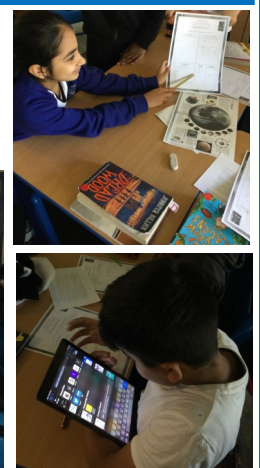
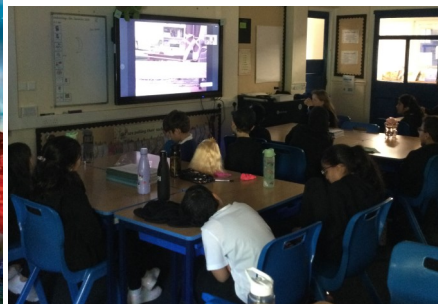
Lacey Y6B said 'Fair Trade is when you work for a company and you get paid the correct amount of money that you should be paid for your job'

Class of the Week for week ending 13 September was Y5C, with an outstanding 100%!

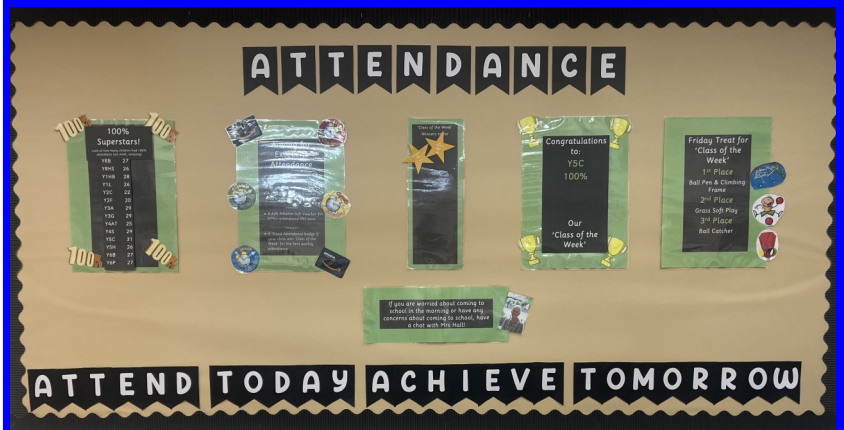


372 of our children had 100% attendance last week. Well done to all of you!

Masie Summers-Newton is a swimmer who has won titles at all levels, including at the Paralympics, and is the current world-record holder for 2 different events. She is also a trained primary school teacher, and states that she wants everyone to believe that 'they can achieve their dreams and ensure there are no barriers in society.'

Delicious Orié is a British boxer who competed at the Paris 2024 Olympics. Orié was born in Moscow to a Nigerian father and a Russian mother and moved to England aged 7 to escape racism. He said people 'need somebody to tell them that things are possible' and wants to inspire children and young adults through his actions.

Kyle Kothari is an English diver who competed at the 2024 Paris Olympics. He showed resilience to make the team after suffering 3 major injuries in 8 years, and is also the first UK Jain athlete to compete at the Olympics. Kothari was the only South-Asian representative for Team GB in the Paris 2024 Olympics.

Cindy Ngamba is a boxer who won the first ever medal for the Refugee Olympic Team, winning bronze in the 2024 Paris Olympics. She moved to the UK aged 11, and studied 'Crime and Criminal Justice' at the University of Bolton. Cindy believes that anyone, refugee or not, 'can achieve whatever you put your mind to.'
