This week we welcomed two new children to Devonshire Road, Covenant (Y3A) and Elena (YRH). We hope you have settled in well.



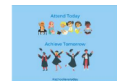
As there was no Celebration Assembly today, our attendance achievements will be celebrated on Monday and shared on next week's newsletter.

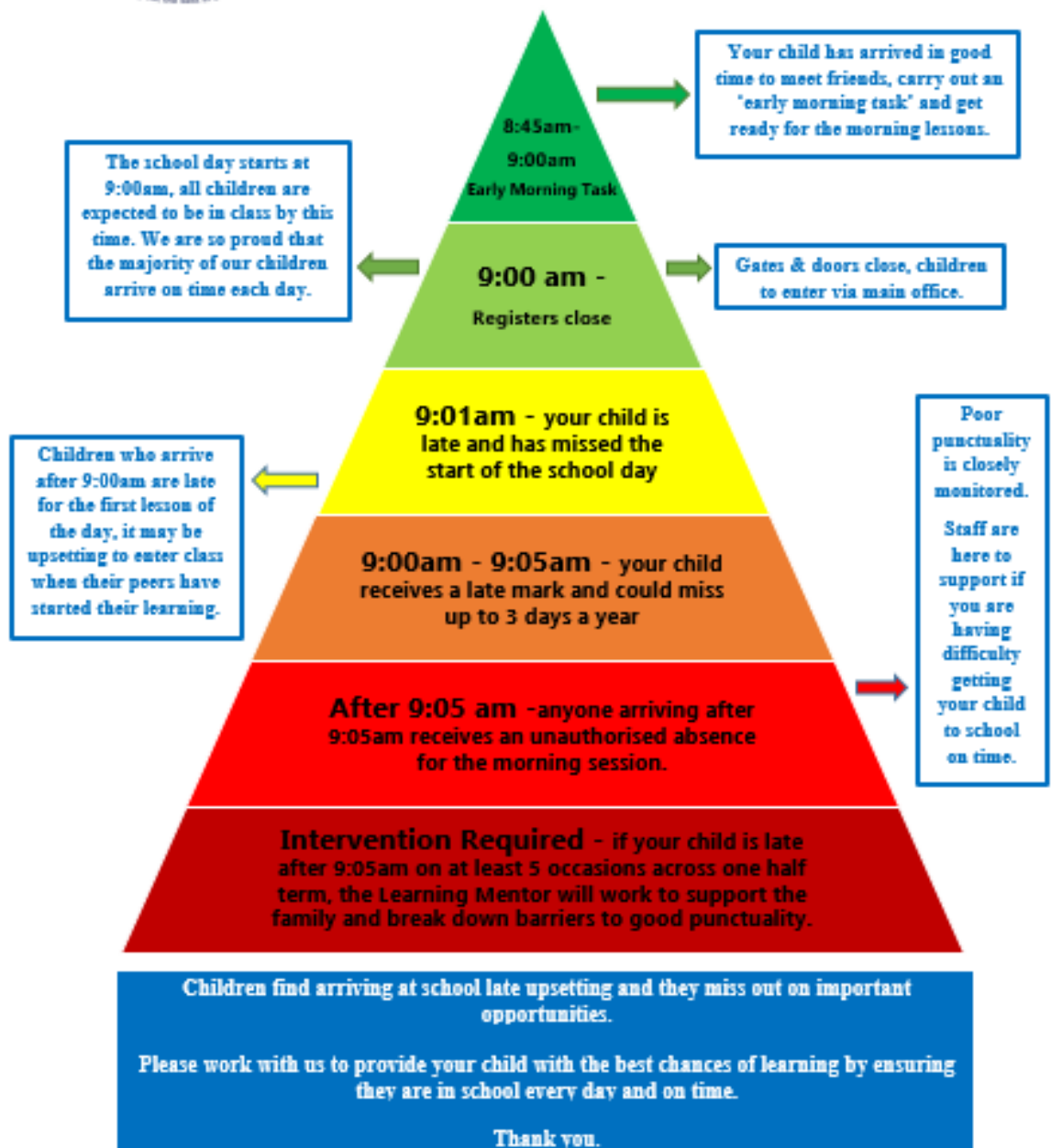
