Dear Parents/Carers,

We are currently working with **Bright Leaders** and they are helping us develop our youth leadership groups in school. To do this, we are working with other primary schools to complete a fun run. **The fun run will take place on Sunday 23rd June and will start at 9am prompt at Queens Park in Bolton.** We anticipate that the event will be completed by 9.45am.

Our student leaders are helping to promote the run and we are hoping to get as many students as possible to join us. You can find details for the run at <https://www.parkrun.org.uk/queenspark-juniors/course>. The event is for 4 to 14 year olds and the course is 2km long. Whilst there can be a competitive edge to the run, our main aim is to have fun and get young people moving. This is a **FREE** and friendly event and all abilities are welcome!

You simply need to register your child here <https://www.parkrun.org.uk/register/>.

Once registered, you'll receive a unique bar code. Bring this, printed, or using a digital version on your phone on the day of the run. This will be presented when your child crosses the finish line which will ensure you receive an official time and place via email.

We ask that you arrive at **8.45am**. This will allow time to park and make your way to the start area. **Children MUST be accompanied by an adult, but the adult does not have to run!**

We would really welcome your support, to break the current Children's Fun Run Record of 142 participants.

The Bolton News will also be reporting on the event.

Additionally, if you register your child and let us know here at school, we will arrange for them to have an extra play and issue them with a certificate.

We are really looking forward to hearing from you.

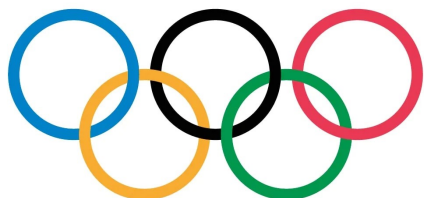

Dessine ton skateboard. Name: Aiza akram Class: 2C



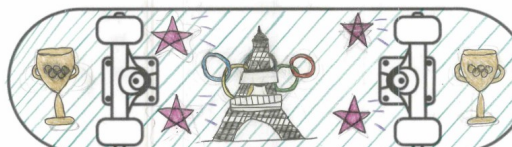
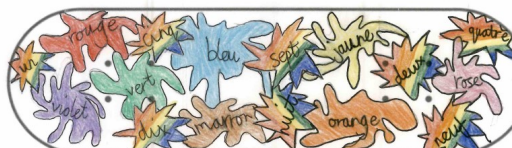

Dessine ton skateboard. Name: Imogen Class: 5D



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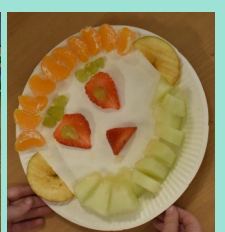


Healthy Living Week
