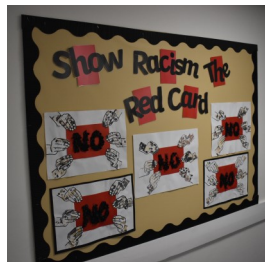
Year 4 First Aid Workshop

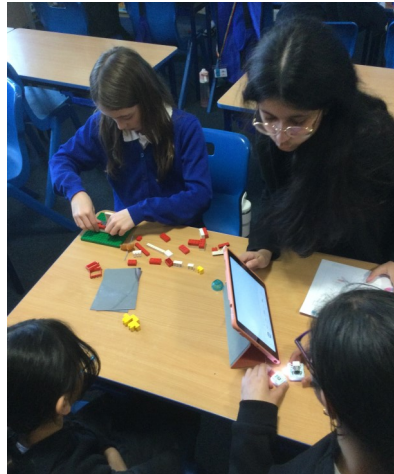
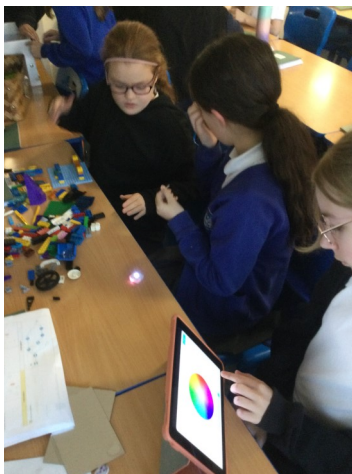
