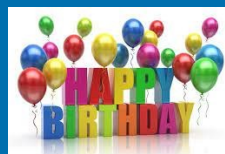


Well done to Amelia In Y4, who has just done her grading for her yellow belt 7th KYU in karate.

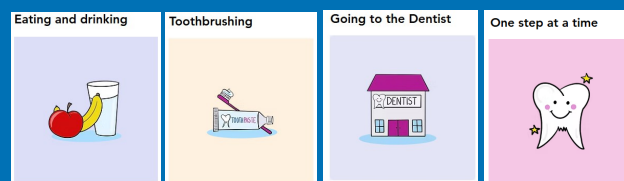
