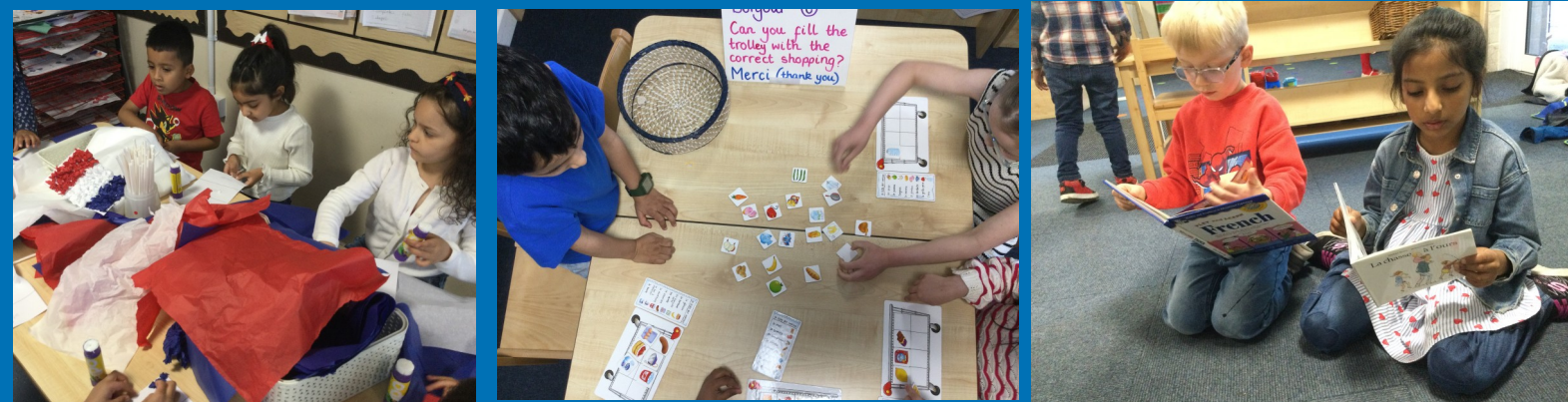
This week in school, we've been celebrating Earth Day. The children have been reading lots of texts all about looking after our planet and thinking about how we can all help to make a difference.

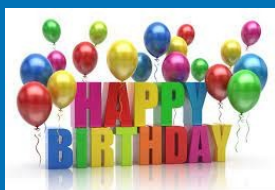

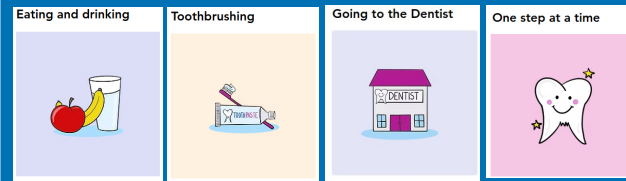

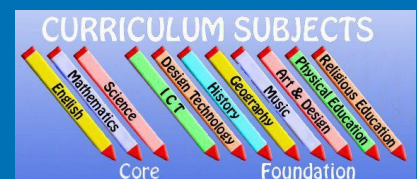
