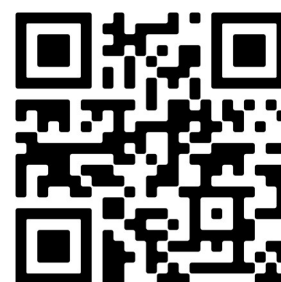

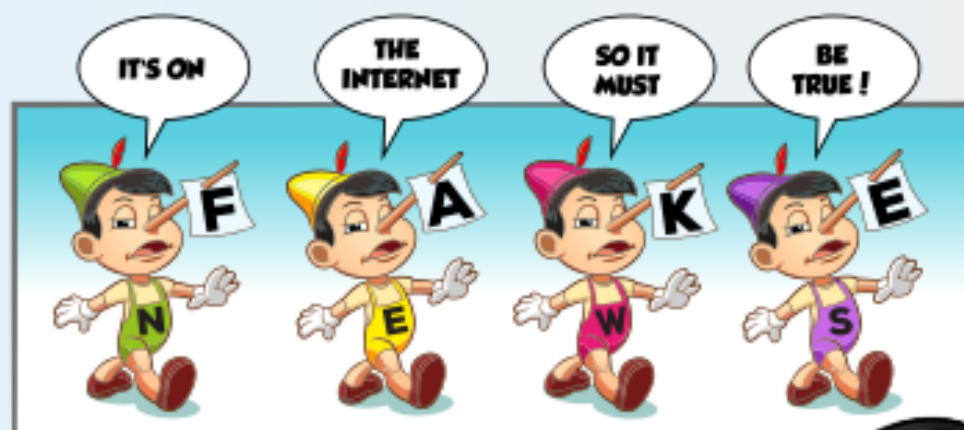
At Devonshire Road Primary School we strive to
