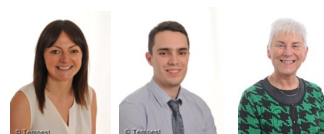

Well done to all of you, what a great start to the school year!

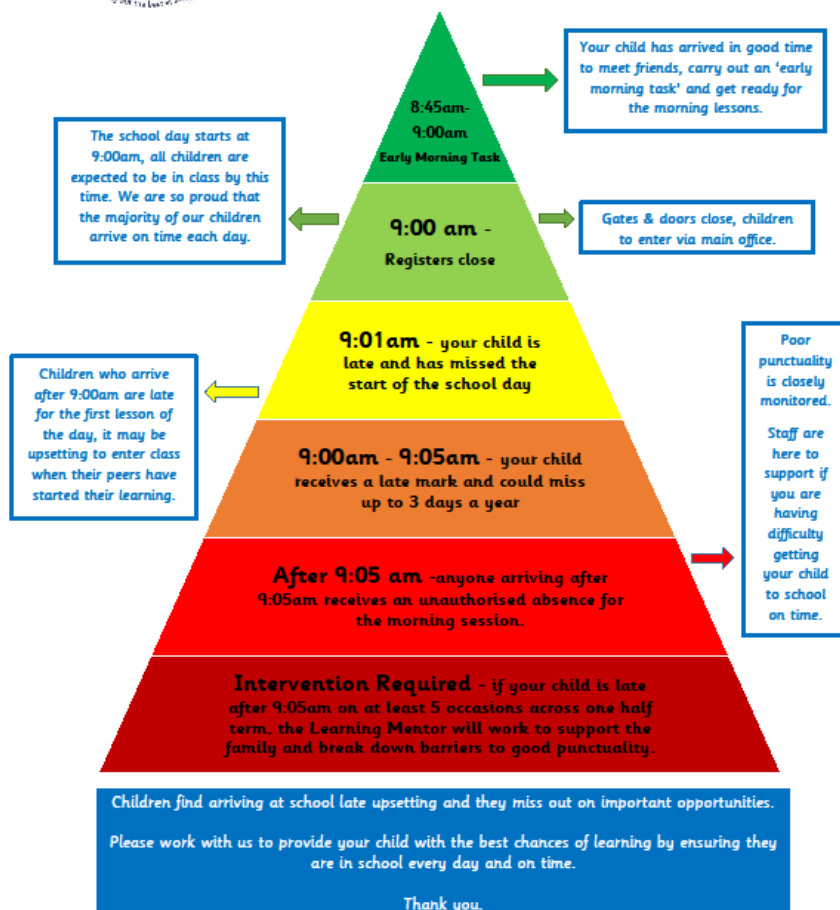

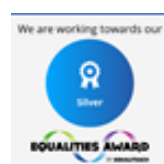
