Every child in each class received a 'Good Attendance' pin badge!

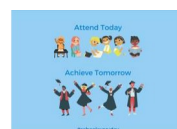


Aiming for Excellent Attendance

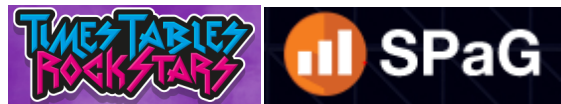
