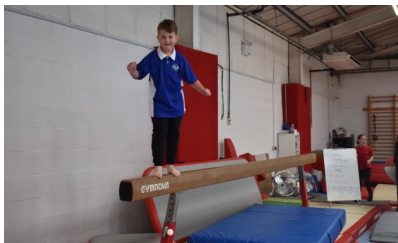
Year 1 Cricket Tournament

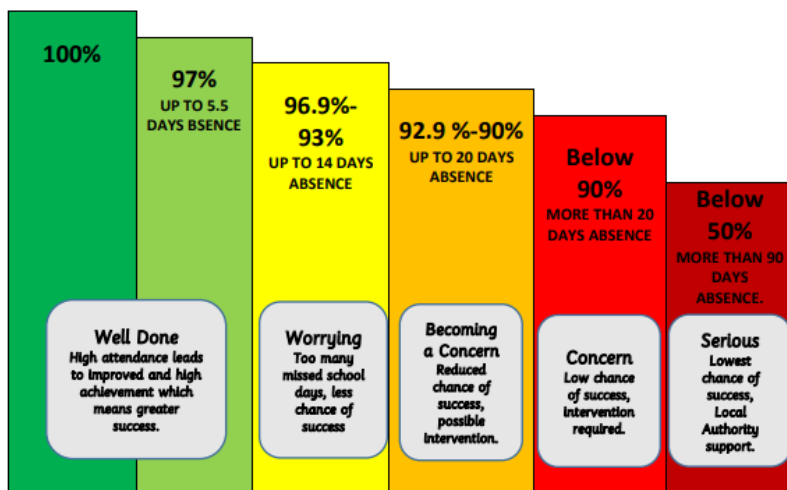

We are excited to announce that three of our staff are now fully trained as Emotional Literacy Support Assistants (ELSAs). Mrs. Hall, Miss. Hopgood and Miss. Ellis have been trained by Bolton Educational Psychology Service to deliver specialised emotional and social well-being support to children in school. They will be working with individuals and groups of children on areas such as anxiety and anger management, friendship issues and the development of emotional literacy. This is in addition to the work of the Bolton Mental Health School Team (BMHST) who also deliver interventions across school.



We are pleased to confirm that this year's Bolton Children's University graduation will take place on the morning of Saturday 5th July 2025 at the University of Greater Manchester (formerly the University of Bolton).



It has been a very successful start to our free half an hour breakfast club, how lovely to see so many of our families benefit from that extra quarter of an hour in the morning.
