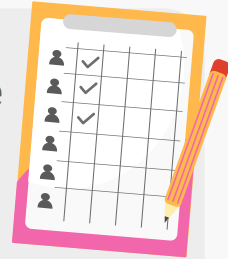

Allergy List

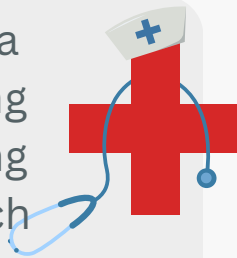
We hold an up-to-date list of all pupils who have allergies.

Staff training

All staff receive asthma and anaphylaxis training from the School Nursing Team in September each year.



Individual Health Plans (IHP)

Children in school with allergies have an IHP.

This outlines triggers, medication needed and what to do if there is a reaction.



Adrenaline Auto Injectors



School holds spare AIs and have them available when on and off site. School will administer AIs where a pupil is suspected to be in anaphylaxis. In emergency cases we may not be able to seek parental permission first.
