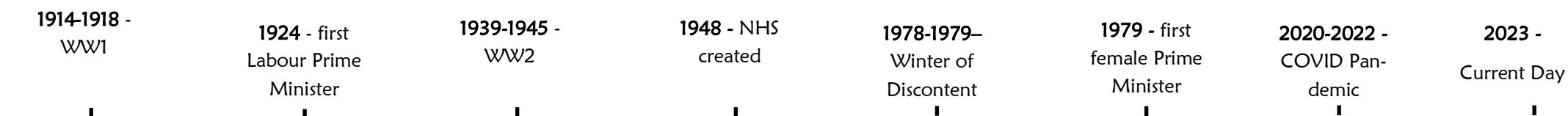

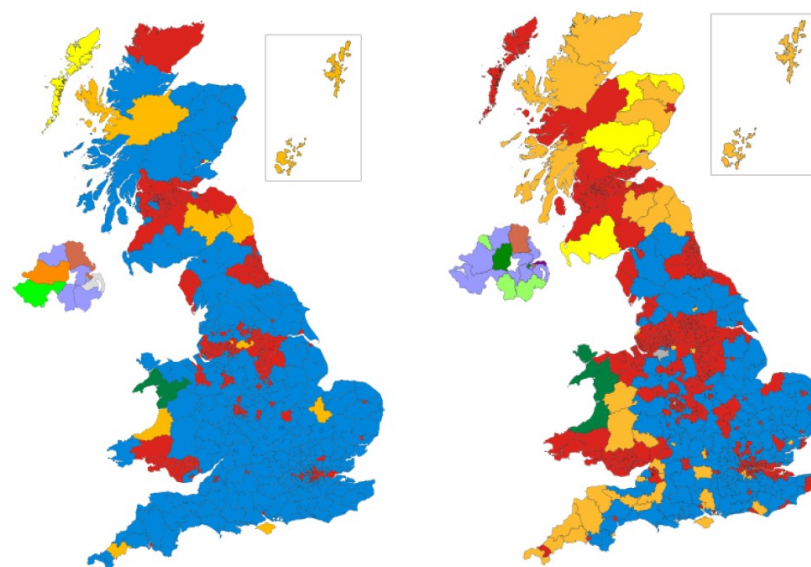
Key Vocabulary

|-------------|---|
| Appeasement | The act of pacifying a country to avoid war |
| Armament | Military weapons and equipment |
| Bias | A favouring of some ideas or people over others |
| Consecutive | Following each other continuously |
| Munitions | Military weapons, ammunition, etc. |
| Propaganda | Information which is biased or misleading used to promote a political message. |
| Press | The news/media. |
| Rationing | Allowing each person to have only a fixed amount of something |
| Reliability | A measure of how reliable something is. |
| Significant | Sufficiently great or important to be worthy of attention |
| Trade Union | An organised association of workers formed to protect and extend the rights of particular jobs/professions. |

- WW1—1914-1918
- WW2—1939-1945
- NHS Established - July 1948
- Winter of Discontent - 1978-1979
- Margaret Thatcher was the longest-serving Prime Minister of the 20th Century.
- Margaret Thatcher was the first ever female Prime Minister of the UK.
- Tony Blair was the first Labour leader to serve 3 consecutive terms as Prime Minister.
- Ramsay MacDonald was the first Labour Prime Minister.
