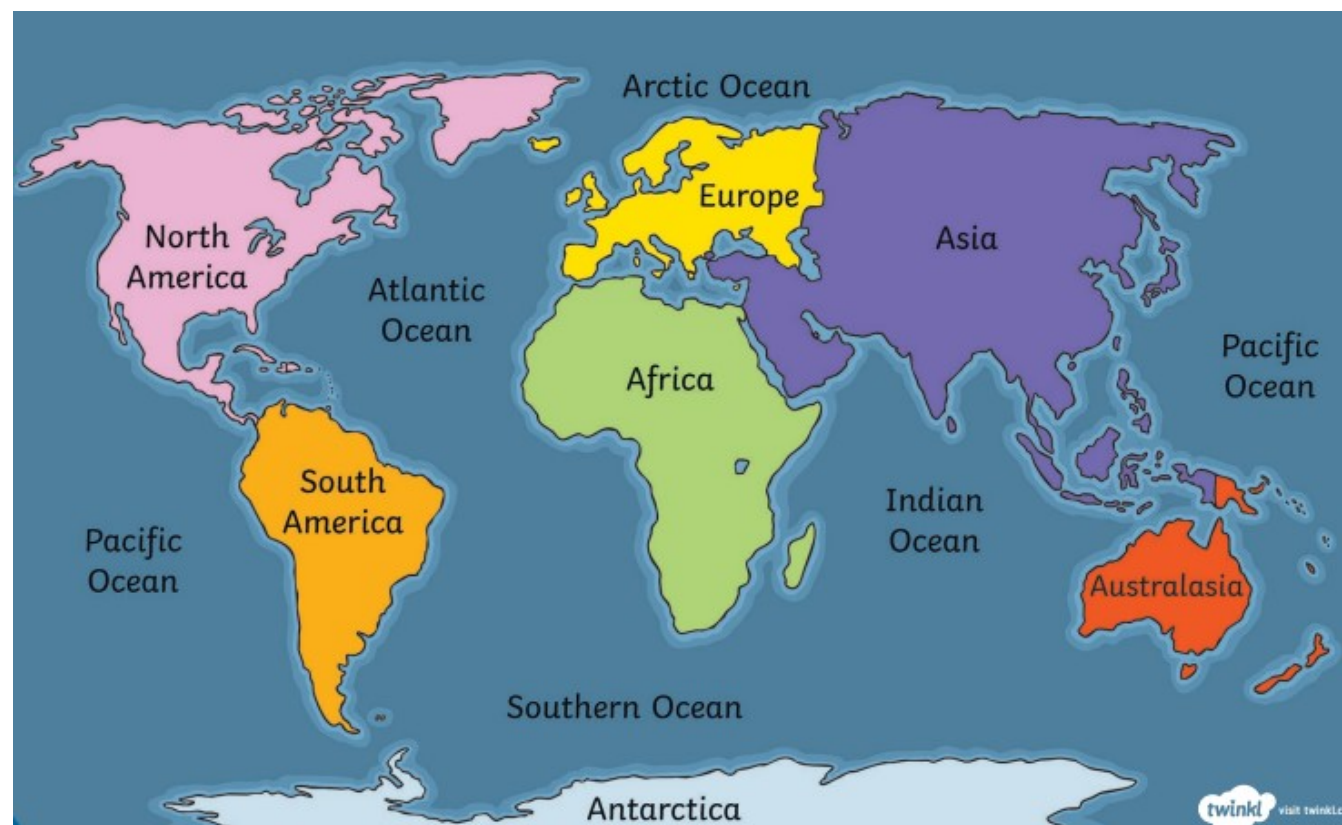

Earth	The Earth is the planet that we all live on.	
Europe	The 6th largest continent in the world. We live in Europe.	
Population	The population of a place is the number of people who live there.	
Temperature	The temperature of a place tells you how hot or cold it is.
