Timeline

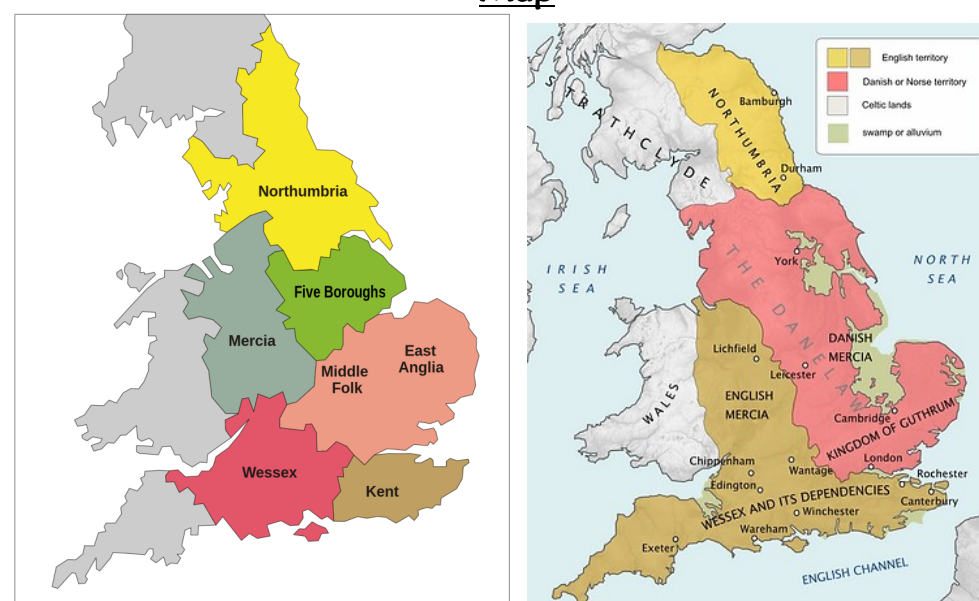
924 Athelstan becomes the first King of England

- Wessex was the leading Kingdom
- King Alfred is the only king to be known as 'Great'
- The Danes ruled an area called the Danelaw.
- England became a Christian country during the Anglo Saxon time.
- Athelstan was the first King of England.
- Danes were kings starting with Cnut.
- Edward the Confessor took the throne back from the Danes but was the last Saxon king.

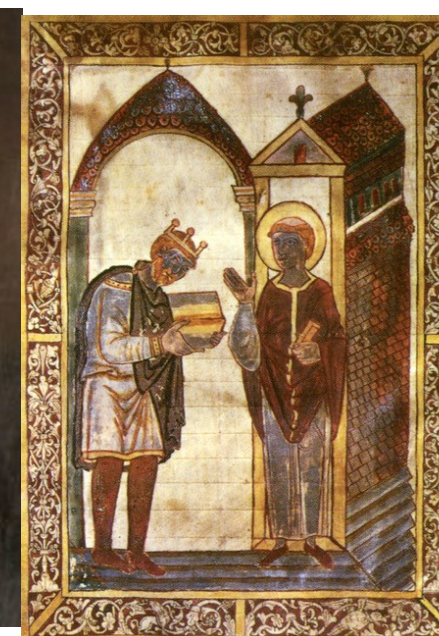
