Glad to report the weather was kind this week for our Y5 children who participated in their Bikeability Course. Here are some of them perfecting their skills. Well done to everyone for your efforts and of course a big thank you to the instructors for their dedication.



This week, the children took part in an assembly about the **WOW Walk to School Challenge**. We are encouraging all children to **walk to school** to help build **healthy habits** and **reduce** our impact on the environment.

Each day, we will use the **Travel Tracker** to record how children travel to school. If the children **walk, cycle, scoot or park and stride** to school at least once a week they get **rewarded** with a monthly-collectable **badge**. These badges are recyclable and designed by children, with a different design to collect each month. Families who **usually drive** can still take part by using 'Park and Stride', park 10 minutes away and walk the rest. We recommend Morrisons as a suitable place to park and stride. The challenge will begin after half term, starting the week commencing 3rd November. Thank you for your support!



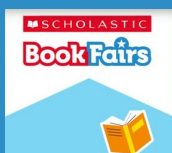
