- How do you think we can be kind in today's world?

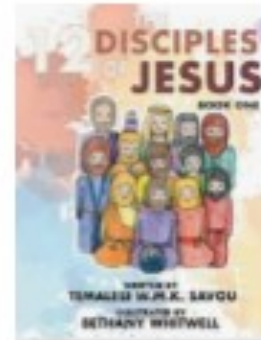
## Key Vocabulary

Gospel	Good news/good story
Neighbour	A person who lives next door or nearby
Leper	A person suffering from leprosy/ A person who is rejected by others for social or moral reasons
Disciples	A personal follower of Christ during his life
clergy	People who are ordained for religious duties, in the Christian Church
Charity	An organisation set up to provide help and raise money for those in need
Samaritan	A member of people inhabiting Samaria in biblical times/ a charitable person
untouchable	A person who is not allowed to be touched/ a member of a low caste group
parable	A simple story to illustrate a moral, as told by Jesus to the Gospels
