This week in Year 4

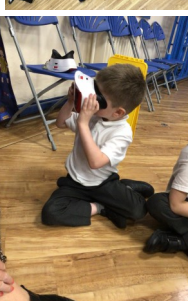

Year 1 Virtual Reality Space Workshop

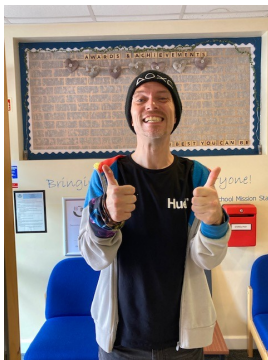
This week we had a very exciting experience with virtual reality. We wore VR goggles to see what it would be like to visit the different planets in the solar system!

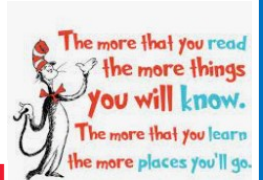
We Love to Read at Devonshire Road
