T shirts and leggings or shorts work well and designs can be added to T-shirts with paper or paint. Superhero boots can be made by using shoes and cardboard round the legs. Green body paint and some shading makes the Hulk.

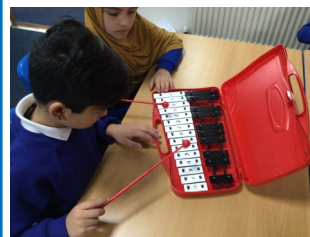
Welcome to Devonshire Road Primary School

Year 3 Music

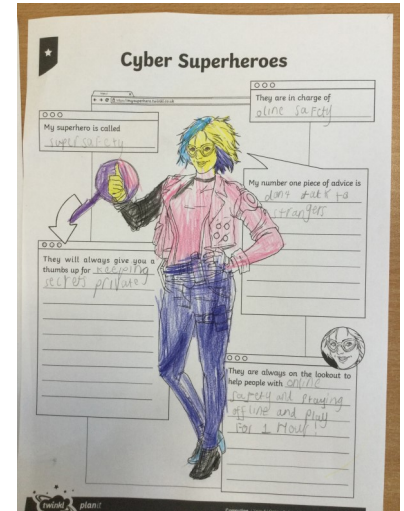
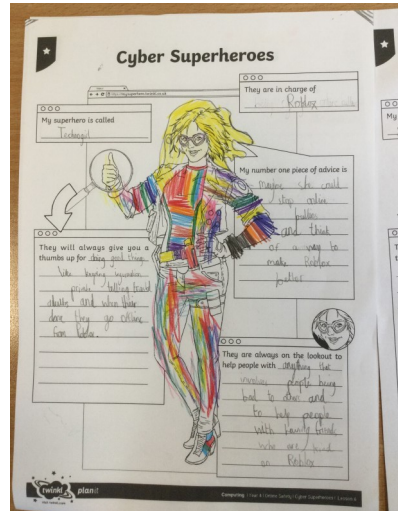
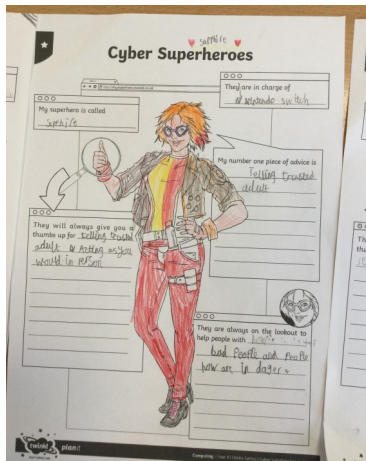
