**1pm** Start of the KS2 sports' day events.

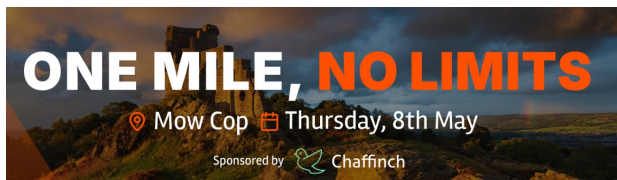
Access in and out of school will be via the main school entrance.
