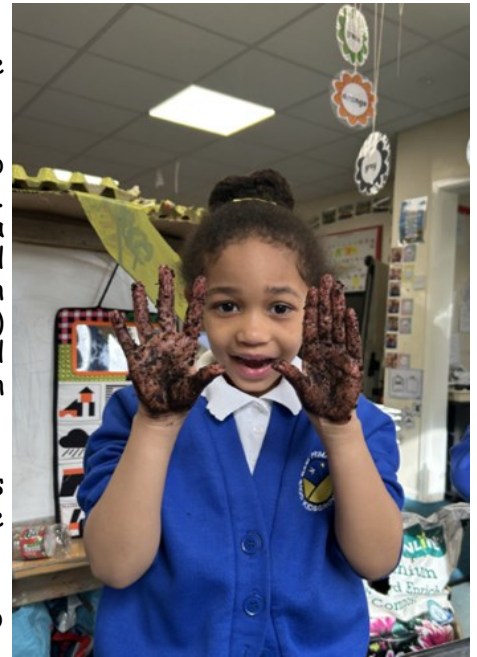
### Science and Sustainability Week
