Staffordshire Music Service

The musicians showed the children a range of instruments that are available to learn in school, including brass, woodwind, string, drums and vocals.

Music lessons are charged, however if you if you need support to pay for them, Staffordshire Music Service have a many ways of fully or partially funding lessons for households who meet the criteria.
