The children had a great time working alongside all our visitors, and they produced cards, crackers, candy canes, to name but a few! More memories have been made and more budding artists discovered!

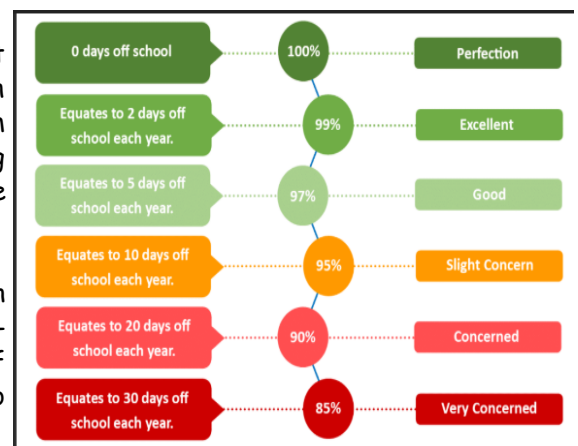
We were not sure who enjoyed it the most, the children or the adults!
